RESOLUTION NO. 22-23

AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF FOUR (4) 29-FT. TRANSIT COACHES

WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable to purchase four (4) 29-ft. Transit Coaches to replace four (4) 2008 model year coaches; and

WHEREAS, TARTA has prepared plans and specifications for the equipment to be purchased cooperatively using a Washington state Department of Transportation (DOT) contract; and

WHEREAS, Washington state DOT received bids that met the required guidelines for use with federal grant funds; and

WHEREAS, Gillig Corporation of Livermore, California, a responsible bidder, has submitted a proposal to Washington state DOT for 29-ft. Transit Coaches at a unit cost of six hundred twenty thousand five hundred forty (\$620,540.00) dollars each for a total cost including a 10% contingency not to exceed three million four hundred twelve thousand nine hundred seventy (\$3,412,970.00) dollars; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has grant monies and match funding available for this purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOLEDO AREA REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY, OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The Chief Executive Officer is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Gillig Corporation for the purchase of four (4) 29-ft. Transit Coaches at a unit cost of six hundred twenty thousand five hundred forty (\$620,540.00) dollars for a total cost including a 10% contingency not to exceed three million four hundred twelve thousand nine hundred seventy (\$3,412,970.00) dollars, such contract to contain the terms and conditions that have been approved by the TARTA Board of Trustees and such other terms as may be in the best interest of TARTA.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That the Secretary-Treasurer is hereby authorized forthwith to certify a copy of this resolution to Gillig Corporation, thereby to notify them of the award of this contract.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. That the Secretary-Treasurer is hereby authorized to make a lawful certification as to the availability of said funds, and to issue warrants against said funds upon presentation of approved vouchers.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
