RESOLUTION NO. 34-23

AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT FOR
PROCURING HARDWARE, INSTALLATION AND ANNUAL MAINTENANCE FOR AN
ON-BOARD SURVEILLANCE SYSTEMS

WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable that the Toledo Area Regional Transit Authority (TARTA) purchase an on-board Surveillance Systems for all revenue vehicles, including the opportunity for live view; and

WHEREAS, TARTA has prepared plans and specifications and asked for bids for the said equipment to be purchased; and

WHEREAS, Safety Vision of Houston, Texas, a responsible bidder has presented a proposal to TARTA for this purchase for approximately Five Hundred Fifty Nine, One Hundred Forty Four dollars (\$559,144); and

WHEREAS, TARTA, desires to upgrade our surveillance infrastructure to all solid state hard drives and other back office upgrades for an additional One Hundred, Thousand dollars (\$100,000) as part of this procurement, plus a 14% contingency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOLEDO AREA REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Chief Executive Officer is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Safety Vision, Houston, Texas, for the purchase of an onboard surveillance systems at a cost not to exceed Seven Hundred Fifty-One Thousand, Four Hundred and Twenty Four dollars (\$751,424).

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
